Updates from Maternal Child Health Literature:

- **A new study published in JAMA pediatrics** examines symptoms of 50 children hospitalized in NYC with COVID-19. Not all children had respiratory symptoms. Disease was least severe in infants. - **In a recent JAMA article**, a study of 82 COVID positive women giving birth in Spain found that among the 95% who presented with mild symptoms, all 53% who delivered vaginally had excellent outcomes, and 13.5% who had cesarean births had severe maternal outcomes such as admission to the ICU. Even after adjusting for confounders, cesareans were independently associated with risk of clinical deterioration. 4.2% of newborns initially tested positive but repeat testing at 48 hours was negative and none developed COVID-19 symptoms.
