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Background: CHAMPS

- CHAMPS (Communities and Hospitals Advancing Maternity Practices) is a breastfeeding-focused initiative geared toward improving maternal and child health outcomes through the promotion of Baby-Friendly practices
- Free to participating hospitals
- Originally funded by the W.K. Kellogg Foundation
- 3 years of funding: 2014-2017
- Kellogg also funds our AI/AN CHAMPS initiative
- Additional funders have included the MS Department of Health, and Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Mississippi








Background: Where CHAMPS Works

- Enroll 25 hospitals in MS, NOLA, S Texas
- Improve MCH practices in 25 hospitals
- Increase breastfeeding rates
- Reduce racial disparities
- Help at least 10 to become Baby-Friendly



CHAMPS clinician trainings

- All training aims to meet Baby-Friendly USA requirements for designation
 - Nursing staff 20 hours (with 5 hours clinical skills training)
 - Hospital physicians 3 hours
- CHAMPS offers in-hospital training, and access to online and train the trainer options
- 961 people trained including nursing staff, physicians, and WIC staff









All CHAMPS: Breastfeeding exclusivity




All CHAMPS: Skin-to-Skin post vaginal births







CHAMPS in Mississippi 2014-17

- Over 80% of <u>ALL</u> birthing hospitals in Mississippi are on the Pathway


MS CHAMPS BFHI 4-D Pathway Status



MS sites: Breastfeeding initiation




MS sites: Exclusive breastfeeding



MS sites: Skin-to-Skin post vaginal birth




MS sites: Skin-to-Skin post Cesarean birth

- CHAMPS South funds expire July 31, 2017
- New funds from the W.K. Kellogg Foundation and Bower Foundation will enable work in Mississippi from Aug 1, 2017 for 3 years
- Goals
 - Enroll new MS hospitals
 - Continue to put communities 1st
 - Improve MCH practices
 - Increase breastfeeding rates
 - Reduce racial disparities
 - Help <u>all</u> MS CHAMPS hospitals to become Baby-Frien



Enrollment: MS CHAMPS

- 18 hospitals in CHAMPS to continue
- 14 new hospitals asked to join so far
- 11 completed application process
- 7 site visited in May/June
- Starting to enroll new hospitals
- Open for applications!

- Part of our new Center for Health Equity, Education, and Research
- We are not Baby-Friendly USA
- Baby-Friendly USA is the non-profit that assesses and designates Baby-Friendly status
- CHAMPS provides TA and support for hospitals seeking Baby-Friendly status
- CHAMPS IS FREE TO HOSPITALS!
